INVITATION for FIGURATIVE PAINTERS and SCULPTORS

ABOUT THE EXHIBITION:

The Kitsch Biennale is this year being held at *Palazzo Cini* in Venice, Italy. The exhibition wishes to present the best figurative works within painting and sculpture.

Due to regulations in Venice, we cannot actively sell paintings. However, representatives will be present, encouraging customers to take direct contact with the respective painters.

THE JURY:

Odd Nerdrum, Bjørn Li, Helene Knoop. Richard T. Scott and David Dalla Venezia.

The jury is not obliged to accept any of the works sent in.

CV, as well as papers from officially accepted art schools are irrelevant for participation.

The only condition is that the works are figurative and made by the applicant.

A winner will be announced and receive a review on WorldWideKitsch.com.

PHASE I: Conditions for participation.

Jury evaluation:

- We need paper photo copies of maximum 5 works - *professionally* photographed. Size 13 x 18 cm / 5 x 7 inches.
- Alternatively, send jpg files by e-mail. Size: minimum 20 cm/ 7,8 inches. 300dpi and in RGB Colourspace. All paintings have to be photographed with a colour-reference card; The Macbeth Colour Checker

Or minimum with a white paper beside the painting.

Deadline: 1. April. 2010.

- Maximum size: 200 x 130 cm, including frame.
- Paintings are recommended to be framed.

- Abstraction falls out of the limits for this exhibition, as do media works such as photo, video, computer technique, installations etc.

Due to logistical issues, the application material will not be returned.

Insurance/shipment:

The applicant is responsible for shipment costs and for insuring the work from the date of sending to the date of reception after the exhibition.

It is important that you agree pick-up with your shipment company beforehand.

Your work must be picked up between 18. – 24. of Oct. 2010. After this period, neither WWK, Cini Palace or place of delivery/pick-up (Toni Dalla Venezia frame shop) will take responsibility for your work. Neither of the three parties will pay tolls for you.

Phase II:

A catalogue will be produced representing the participants.

Those who are accepted for the Kitsch Biennale will be contacted through email .

DEADLINES

- 1. April. 2010: Delivery of application (including paper photo copies / jpps).
- 15. April 2010: Date of notice after Phase I. Sending of material for catalogue.
- 30. Aug. - 10. Sep. 2010: Delivery of accepted work for The Kitsch Biennale 2010.
- 18. - 24. Oct. 2010: Return shipment of work.
